## *Block G Award Program*

Every student at Lyman Gilmore has the potential to receive the Block G Award for achievements and participation at school. Awards are given to qualified 8th grade applicants in the spring.

Being a scholar student, artist, athlete, a leader/servant throughout their 6<sup>th</sup>, 7<sup>th</sup> and 8<sup>th</sup> grade years at Gilmore is worthy of respect and recognition! Each spring, we hold a special ceremony to honor our Block G recipients and their parents or guardians. Students who submit their application and qualify as recipients of the award will receive an exclusive letter of invitation to the event.

How to apply: 8<sup>th</sup> graders who choose to participate in the Block G program may complete the attached form to tally points for accomplishments in school and school-sponsored activities. To earn a Block G, points must be earned in each of the following categories: Academics, Arts, Athletics, and Leadership/Service. When the required point total from each of the categories, along with additional points in any area, equals a minimum of 30 points, the student may be eligible to earn the Block G.

**Each Block G applicant must complete the Block G Award Program form and submit it to the office by the deadline, Wednesday, April 30.**

*Please note:* Good attendance, behavior, and citizenship are very important aspects to receiving the Block G Award. A student with

poor citizenship, receiving suspensions, or other disciplinary issues, may be disqualified from receiving the Block G Award.
