

Block G Award Program

Every student at Lyman Gilmore has the potential to receive the Block G Award for achievements and participation at school. Being a scholar student, an artist, an athlete, a leader, and a participant, throughout their years at Gilmore is worthy of respect and recognition! Each spring, we hold a special ceremony and dinner to honor our Block G recipients and their parents or guardians. Students who qualify as recipients of the award will receive a special letter of invitation to the event, which will be in the Spring.

Students choosing to participate in the Block G program tally points toward the award for accomplishments in school and school-sponsored activities. In order to earn a Block G, points must be earned in each of five categories: Academics, Arts, Athletics, Leadership, and School Service. When the required point total from the various categories is equal to 30, the student may be eligible to earn the Block G.

Each Block G applicant must complete the Block G Award Program form and submit it to the office by the deadline, TBD. The Block G form is attached.

Please note that good behavior and citizenship are an important aspect to receiving the Block G Award. Any student receiving an N or U for citizenship or has had disciplinary issues, may be disqualified from receiving the Block G Award. *Administration will give final approval of all application.*
