

# ***Block G Award Program***

Every student at Lyman Gilmore has the potential to receive the Block G Award for achievements and participation at school. Being a scholar student, an artist, an athlete, a leader, and a participant, throughout their 6<sup>th</sup>, 7<sup>th</sup> and 8<sup>th</sup> grade years at Gilmore is worthy of respect and recognition! Each spring, we hold a special ceremony and dinner to honor our Block G recipients and their parents or guardians. Students who qualify as recipients of the award will receive a special letter of invitation to the event, which will be held in Spring.

6<sup>th</sup>, 7<sup>th</sup> and 8<sup>th</sup> graders who choose to participate in the Block G program may complete the attached form to tally points for accomplishments in school and school-sponsored activities. To earn a Block G, points must be earned in each of five categories: Academics, Arts, Athletics, Leadership, and School Service. When the required point total from the various categories, along with additional points in any area, equal a minimum of 30, the student may be eligible to earn the Block G.

**Each Block G applicant must complete the Block G Award Program form and submit it to the office by the deadline, Wednesday, April 11.**

*Please note:* Good behavior and citizenship are a very important aspect to receiving the Block G Award. Any student receiving an N or U for citizenship or has had disciplinary issues, may be disqualified from receiving the Block G Award.
