## These students routinely go above and beyond what is expected. Attitude: Always displays a delightfully positive attitude and a passion for learning. Behavior: Always respectfully obeys school/class rules and the directions of the teacher. Study Skills: Always on time, organized, and ready to learn with required supplies. Work Habits: Always a hard worker. Industrious. Solves problems. Takes initiative. Respect for others: Always polite and very respectful of others. Follows the Golden Rule. Cooperation: Positive, thoughtful collaborator and contributor. Respected group member. Outstanding Leadership: Can be counted on to be a strong, positive leader in class and on campus. These students consistently do their jobs every day. Attitude: Almost always displays a positive attitude and willingness to learn. Behavior: Almost always obeys school/class rules and the directions of the teacher. Study Skills: Almost always on time, organized, ready to learn with required supplies. Work Habits: Almost always a hard worker. Industrious. Solves problems. On task. Respect for others: Shows respect and politeness to others. Follows the Golden Rule. Cooperation: Almost always a positive, thoughtful collaborator and contributor. Leadership: Almost always a strong, positive leader in class and on campus. These students do enough to get by, but little more. Attitude: Usually positive, but occasionally displays negative or self-centered attitude. Behavior: Usually follows rules and directions. May be occasionally disruptive. Study Skills: Usually organized and ready to learn. May sometimes be missing supplies. Work Habits: Work level and quality usually meets minimum requirements, rarely more. Respect for others: Usually, but not always, respectful and polite to others. Cooperation: Usually works well with others. May rarely be off task or a non-contributor. Satisfactory Leadership: May show little to no leadership, but not usually negative leadership.

These citizenship grades disqualify a student from the Honor Roll and Principal's List as well as other privileges.

## These students frequently do not meet citizenship expectations. Attitude: Sometimes positive, but often displays a negative or self-centered attitude. Behavior: Often does not follow school/classroom rules or the directions of the teacher. Study Skills: Often disorganized and unprepared for class. Often missing supplies. Work Habits: Often shows an unwillingness to work hard or produce quality products. Respect for others: Sometimes disrespectful or showing a lack of awareness of others. Cooperation: Often a non-contributor or a distraction in group situations. Leadership: Shows either no leadership whatsoever, or leadership that is often negative. **Improvement** These students show a blatant disregard for citizenship expectations. Attitude: Negative attitude, often showing an unwillingness to improve citizenship. Behavior: May show a complete disregard for rules and contempt for authority. Study Skills: Usually disorganized and unprepared for class. Often missing supplies. Work Habits: Often shows an unwillingness to complete any work at all. Respect for others: Often shows blatant disrespect and a lack of awareness of others. Cooperation: Non-contributor. A distraction in group work, often drawing others off task.

Leadership: Shows either no leadership whatsoever, or negative leadership.
